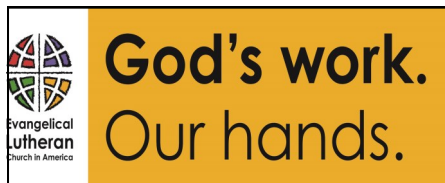

Both of these passages start with the words, "Do not be afraid..." In fact it is reported that this phrase occurs 365 times in our scriptures. I wonder why?! Could it be that fear is paralyzing and keeps us from moving forward in life? Could it be that fear binds our hearts and keeps us from hearing God's voice? Keeps us bound up so that we search for our own solution to problems rather than turning to God? Read these texts, then make a list of your top 5 fears. Hold that list in your hands, close your eyes and imagine giving that list of fears to God. Can you see his hands? Will you place it in the palm of God's hand? Now imagine God taking it, destroying it or at least holding it for you. What does God offer in place of the list of fear? Ask God to unlock the fear that binds you, to release you to move forward in life, as God's beloved child, filled with God's love.
