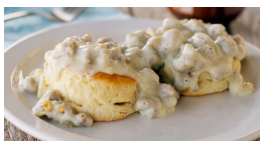
PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY MEETING will meet tomorrow (7/23), 10:00 a.m. in conference room.
