## Early February 2021

### Ashes

I feel like I have ashes in my mouth; the ashes of mourning and loss from sitting alone these past 11 months, waiting for church to re-open. As we approach Ash Wednesday and another disconnected Lent, I feel a deeper bond to this season, and especially Ash Wednesday. The first recorded use of ashes was in 10th century Germany, and it was a sprinkle of ash over the people and a reading from Genesis 3.19 where the Lord punishes Adam and Eve, reminding them they are created from dust of the earth and shall return to it. The imposition of an ash cross most likely dates from the late 19th or early 20th century, and was a reminder of the connection of our dying in baptism and being raised to new life in Christ. The earlier practice connects us to our mortality, reminding us how once people were buried in the dirt of the land. The later practice is about our yearly return to God in sorrow, seeking forgiveness.

This Ash Wednesday, we have a reason to reclaim an ancient practice, to be in solidarity with the almost 500,000 families who have lost a loved one to COVID. We will not be marked with an ashen cross, but rather will have an opportunity to receive a bag with ash mixed with soil, a reminder of our mortality and how Christ broke the bonds of eternal death. We will remember Genesis 3, "remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" with a new sense of connectedness to each other and a world shaped by pandemic.

During Lent, there will be a variety of items provided to help your devotional life, from reflection cards to postings on Face Book and the LSLC website. There will be uploaded reflections as well for both families and adults. The use of these items during a season of 40 days, is to encourage your return to the Lord your God, who is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. This return happens as you practice the 3 discipline of Lent, prayer, fasting, and giving. There will be tools offered which will help you, as well as some on-line recordings each week. I'm still mourning the lack of in-person worship, yet I celebrate that we will try together to be in this season in new ways.


#### FAMILY Lent in a Bag-Holy Week in a Bag


