One day, a professor announced a pop quiz. He handed out the papers, asked the class to turn over the page and begin, but there were no questions on the paper – just a black dot in the center of the page. "I want you to write a few lines about what you see on the paper", the professor said. Puzzled, the students started the test. Once everyone was finished, the professor collected all the tests and started reading the essays out loud. Without exception, each student had written about the black dot, trying to describe its size, position, or color. One by one, the professor read each essay and then spoke to the class. "There is no grade on this test. But I want you to ponder something. All of you wrote about the black dot, no one wrote about the white part of the paper. Everyone focused on the black dot – and the same happens in our lives. This is exactly what we do with our lives. We have a white paper to hold onto and enjoy, but we are so busy contemplating about the dark spots that's there. Life is a special gift and we will always have reasons to celebrate.

And yet we insist on focusing only on the dark spots – the health issues, the money we need, the luxuries we don't have, complications and problems, disappointments and failures and so on.

We need to realize that the dark spots are few in number and often very small And yet we allow these to control our minds. Take your eyes away from the black spots in life. Enjoy each one of your blessings, each moment that life gives you."

Focusing on the white paper and not only the dark spot is another way to describe the journey of faith. Looking for the good is looking for God's presence. This does not deny or avoid the problems in our life. Instead we realize that with God, the darkness does not overwhelm us.

1 John 1:5-7 God is light and in him there is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

We can focus on the black dots, the problems and pain of our lives, our world, or we can look for the good, for God. This is the journey of faith! Love one another and always remember God in Christ Jesus is the One who holds you forever.

Currently The Salvation Army is assisting nearly **700** women and children across hotels and apartments in Charlotte. Since the early onset of the pandemic the decision was made to offer solutions to families that would protect them from contracting and spreading COVID. With the help of the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County and other agencies we began to transition families and single women into hotels to provide the space needed to socially distance. All clients are still receiving case management from our team of social workers, and those that do not have access to food and nutrition services are receiving daily meals. The current plan is to start transitioning some of the families back to the Center of Hope in early April. During this time we are still continuing to move families that have a source of income out of hotels and
