In early April, I wrote how a congregation is like an airport, not the final destination, only a point in the journey which helps you get to where you want to go. Airports connect you to destinations and people; congregations too seek to connect people to God, to each other, and to the community. The Church is all about connection, both as a goal and as an outcome.

As a goal, Living Saviour has a variety of ways we connect and invite you to participate in those connections. We do this so that you feel that you belong here, that you are part of something bigger than yourself, and that you are nourished by the connections.

As we reengage from COVID lockdowns, remember we have the knitting group, Caring and Sharing, quilt ministry, Tuesday and Wednesday study groups, as well as choir and handbell ministries. As our connections deepen, we continue to connect further, to invite others in and all feel more connection! Consider the Election Coffee Table as a way of connecting to our neighbors, as well as each other, as we talk, laugh and share. We seek to build connections within the community and with those who enter our space to vote.

Sunday worship, along with Gathering@theTable, our Thursday night "dinner church" where we are nourished by a meal, by holy conversation and holy communion, are our primary and most public connections. We rejoice that as COVID fear is reduced, more connections will occur in worship and in the myriad opportunities outside of worship. We connect to God through worship and study opportunities. In small groups and large gatherings, we build connections to each other through caring relationships and fellowship; and to the community and world through acts of service.

All are welcome, all are invited to connect.
