Follow Summer Safety: Lie Down in Peace

“In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, LORD, make me dwell in safety.” Psalm 4:8



The health focus for July is **Summer Safety**:

- Every year emergency room (ER) visits spike as temperatures rise and people spend more time outdoors.
- Study by Kaiser Permanente showed a 27% spike in visits to the ER from Memorial Day to Labor Day
- Although different medical groups in different regions of the country prioritize different safety alerts, there is a general consensus regarding being attentive to the following:
- Heat and Sun exposure (Hydration/Dehydration)
 - Insect exposure
 - Sports injuries especially water related accidents.
 - Foodborne Illnesses
 - Monitor Medication
 - Avoid Poison Ivy or Oak
 - Burns

25 June 2023 LSLC Council Meeting

Marty Jenkins, chairperson of the call committee, gave the council an update on where the call committee stands in the call process.

The financial report for the period ending 23 May 2023 shows the General Fund income ahead of Expenses by \$4,341. The revised income projection for the General Fund is \$302,028 for giving plus \$11,000 in other income for a total of \$313,028 for this fiscal year. This is against budgeted income of \$354,160.

Stewardship committee is working on an 18 month plan for giving. A letter from the committee will be sent to all members soon.

The contract for the new LED sign should be signed soon. The contract for painting in the education building and the Sanctuary is ready but could be revised to include additional areas.

The church has welcomed five new members and there is the possibility of a few more soon.

The next meeting will be on 16 July 2023.
