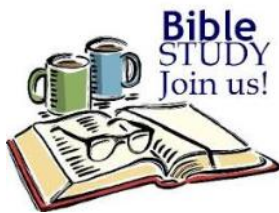
Wednesday Morning Bible Study

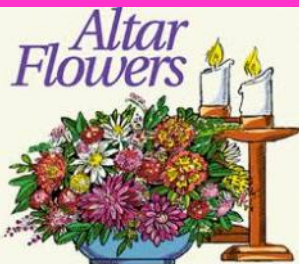

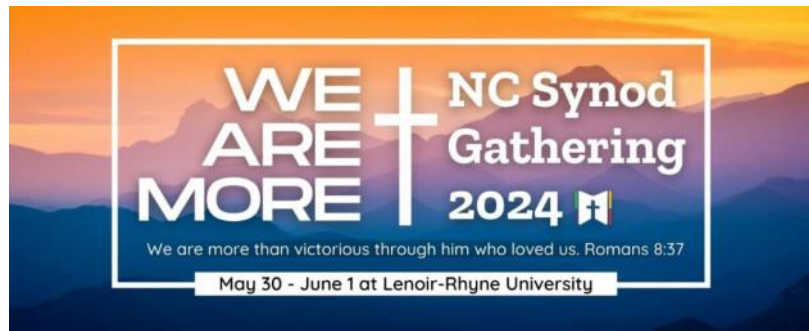

Summary of 17 March 2024 LSLC Council Meeting

Council got the yearly financial budget report and the church did finish the year with a slight surplus. Funds were approved for the repair of the damaged organ pipes.

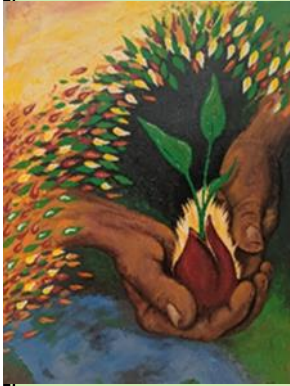
Health and Wholeness discussed the fire evacuation plan that is being developed and some suggestions were made in the plan by council. The changes will be added to the plan and submitted to council at its next meeting. Council was reminded of the Family Dementia Conference and Resource Fair being presented by the Alzheimer's Association at Living Saviour on Saturday 20 April 2024 from 1-5pm.

There was discussion on the planned Easter breakfast and Easter bags for the children.

Faith Formation confirmed that the confirmation youth will be going to Lutheridge on April 18-21 and to the Dwelling in Winston-Salem on Sunday April 28. The youth had a pancake breakfast this morning, along with Lucky Charms pound cake.

The facilities use committee developed a list of prioritizations for building use. We are not able to have an online room reservation until we finish upgrading our internet capabilities. The last time room fees were reviewed was 2016, so we need to review that and see if any changes need to be made.

The next council meeting will be on Sunday 21 April 2024 after worship service.

I am pleased to report that Living Saviour ended the fiscal year with a modest \$4,081 excess of income over expenses. This result is due to the savings of \$42,595 during the eight-month pastoral vacancy, the generous additional financial gifts from the congregation in the Summer of 2023 and the Council's careful management of church expenses. Living Saviour is so very grateful for the gifts of time, talent, dedication, generosity and love you have shown again this past year.
