Notice of a Called Congregation Meeting to take place immediately after worship on Sunday, June 2, 2024. The purpose of this meeting is to accept a proposal from MoistureLoc Inc. to remediate water ingress under the stairwell in the lower floor of the education building. At our Church Council meeting today, the Council unanimously approved a motion to proceed with the proposal. A Congregation Meeting and Congregation approval is required as the projected cost of this remediation was not included in our annual budget and will exceed 4% of that budget. Due to heavy rains this year, the issue needs to be corrected. More information will follow.

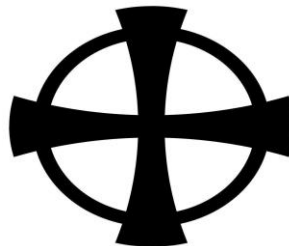

June 2024 Health and Wholeness tip 1 H/W ministry team

The Health and Wholeness focus for June is Disease Prevention through Exercise

Physical activity can prevent or control high blood pressure, heart attack and stroke as well as diabetes. The World Health Organization recommends children and teens average 60 minutes /day of moderate to vigorous exercise. Adults need at least 150 hours/week(30 minutes 5x/week) of moderate to vigorous exercise.

If you believe there are any supplies needed, please leave a note for Ruth on her desk with your name or contact Alice Jenkins. Thank you!

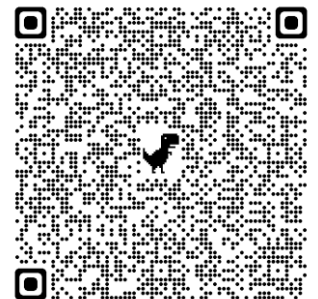
