Alleluia! Christ is risen!
Christ is risen indeed! Alleluia!

Yep, that's right...we are still in the season of Easter – but before we know it, the long season of Pentecost will be upon us. If I'm being honest I have mixed-feelings about the season of Pentecost. On the one hand, it goes on for sooooo many weeks, and it is so very "ordinary" (one of the reasons it is part of what the church calls "ordinary time"). On the other hand, it goes on for sooooo many weeks, and it is so very ordinary. Mundane even. In a sense that is, at one time, the challenge and the joy of it all.

The Spirit (which is what we "celebrate" on Pentecost Sunday and which, according to the telling of its coming in Acts, causes all to speak in languages that each can understand...kind of the un-doing of the Tower of Babel) is present in and through it all. The extra-ordinary and the plain old ordinary. In the times of great joy and deep sorrow...and in the times of "every day." Therein is the great thanksgiving of it all. Never are we away from the Spirit. Never.

That said, we can (and often do) only "feel" the Spirit's presence when we gather for festival worship with all of the proverbial smells and bells. When we pull out all of the stops. Don't get me wrong, I LOVE smells and bells. But even when those things are absent, even in the silence, even outside of the sanctuary, even when we don't *feel* it, the Spirit is present in and through and among us. Equipping us to communicate...To listen. To look. To ask questions. To work toward understanding. To be still even. And that takes time – sooooo many weeks, and it can feel interminably long and boring. But always, God the Spirit is working in and among us, moving us toward growth...Which is why the color of Pentecost season is green (green things remind us of growth). And it is good to be reminded that growth takes time.

Luther said this:

"This life therefore is not righteousness, but growth in righteousness, not health, but healing, not being but becoming, not rest but exercise. We are not yet what we shall be, but we are growing toward it, the process is not yet finished, but it is going on, this is not the end, but it is the road. All does not yet gleam in glory, but all is being purified."

You are each a blessing to me, traveling companions (so to speak) as we continue our journey (at times joyous and at times laborious) in growth.

The Adult Sunday School class will continue meeting into the summer to discuss Amy-Jill Levine's book, **The Bible With and Without Jesus: How Jews and Christians Read the Same Stories Differently.** The discussions will begin on May 4 @ 9:15 am in the Education Wing Room 6. PLEASE join us!!

Esteemed Bible scholars and teachers Amy-Jill Levine and Marc Z. Brettler take readers on a guided tour of the most popular Hebrew Bible passages quoted in the New Testament to show what the texts meant in their original contexts and then how Jews and Christians, over time, understood those same texts. Passages include the creation of the world, the role of Adam and Eve, the Suffering Servant of Isiah, the book of Jonah, and Psalm 22, whose words, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me," Jesus quotes as he dies on the cross.

Comparing various interpretations – historical, literary, and theological - of each ancient text, Levine and Brettler offer deeper understandings of the original narratives and their many afterlives. They show how the text speaks to different generations under changed circumstances, and so illuminate the Bible's ongoing significance. By understanding the depth and variety by which these passages have been, and can be, understood, *The Bible With and Without Jesus* does more than enhance our religious understandings, it helps us to see the Bible as a source of inspiration for any and all readers.
